Mike and Sue Hollern

Central Oregon Community Builders

Few have contributed more to make Central Oregon thrive than Mike and Sue Hollern. As chair of Brooks Resources, Mike Hollern was instrumental in developing Black Butte Ranch, Mt. Bachelor Village Resort, and even the famous Bend roundabouts. Sue Hollern has dedicated her leadership and expertise to causes and organizations such as Art in Public Places, Cascade Child Center, SMART, and Family Access Network.



Tony Hopson, Sr. Trailblazer for Youth and Family Services

As founder of Self Enhancement, Inc. (SEI), Tony Hopson, Sr. grew a youth summer program into one of the most respected human service organizations in Oregon. SEI offers wraparound services for over 17,000 students a year, improving every aspect of their lives. Hopson is also on the founding board of the 1803 Fund, a community investment fund dedicated to rebuilding and strengthening the historic Black community in Portland.



Patricia "Pat" Reser

Champion for the Performing Arts and Education

A lifelong learner and teacher, Pat Reser has always found ways to make a difference. She oversees the board of Reser's Fine Foods as well as the Reser Family Foundation. Her leadership at Oregon State University (OSU) was instrumental to the university's growth, and her passion for the arts led to the creation of flourishing performing arts centers in Beaverton and Corvallis.



Jordan D. Schnitzer

Art Advocate and Civic Leader

As the owner of one of the world's most notable art collections, Jordan Schnitzer was dubbed "The People's Collector" by Artnet for his passion for sharing art with audiences across the globe.
